



As the debate about the IHRA definition rages on, Simon Wiesenthal Center South American Director, Dr. Ariel Gelblung, represented the Center at the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) plenary in Dubrovnik, Croatia.

Dr. Gelblung participated in a wide-range of discussions including the annual Nazi marches in Europe, how to promote awareness of the Holocaust when hate is spread on social media, and detailed analyses of anti-Semitism in Spain, The Netherlands, Norway and the Czech Republic.

Dr. Gelblung also briefed the plenary on the ongoing battle undertaken by the Wiesenthal Center in fighting anti-Semitism in sports; highlighting the Center's successes including the adoption of the Wiesenthal Center's '11-Points Program Against Racism, Xenophobia and Discrimination,' the adoption of the IHRA definition of anti-Semitism by the Argentinian Soccer Association and seven of the First Division
